

## DataChecker Configuration (Release 2026-03)

In this release, an improvement has been made to the Right-to-Work check when it is requested for the candidate via the SecureIDLink.

The Right-to-Work check has been expanded by combining different documents that all serve to determine the right to work. These are now combined under one Datachecker document type WORK-PERMIT including the validity dates.

The following documents can be stored as a right to work. This considers the order of the available documents, with the first document having more priority over the second, etc.

1. A work permit (Datachecker type: WORK-PERMIT).
2. An explanation of the right to work (RTW DOCUMENT)
3. A residence permit if it also gives permission to work. (RESIDENCE PERMIT or RESIDENCE PERMIT STICKER)

This allows the same document to be used for both residence and work permit processes.

When no documents are available, but the Right to Work check has been approved, a work permit document is automatically created. In that case without an attachment, but including validity dates and approval information. For example, in a Right-to-work check for people with a Dutch identity.

**Please note:** as soon as a WORK-PERMIT document has been set up, the validity dates will be entered here. The validity dates of the residence permit are no longer sent from datachecker because only the right to work is relevant. That is why only the validity dates are fixed for the right to work.

## Setup

### Object management

Go to Setup – Object Manager – Document type

In the DataChecker Document Type field, add the following value: "Right to work" with the API Name "WORK\_PERMIT".

## Document type

Go to 'Document type' via the app launcher and create a new Document type with the name: 'Right to work' for the object Person.

1. Valid from and valid until are both required
2. Set DataChecker approval to 'on'
3. For DataChecker document type, choose Right to work
